1887	Raised issue about corrupt Court official who stole shoes from a bankrupt Petitioned against: (i) the sale of intoxicants on Sundays (ii) the abolition of Sunday postal labour
1889	<u>Irish issues:</u> Helped Irish tenantry against wrongful eviction; 3 mths in Derry Jail
